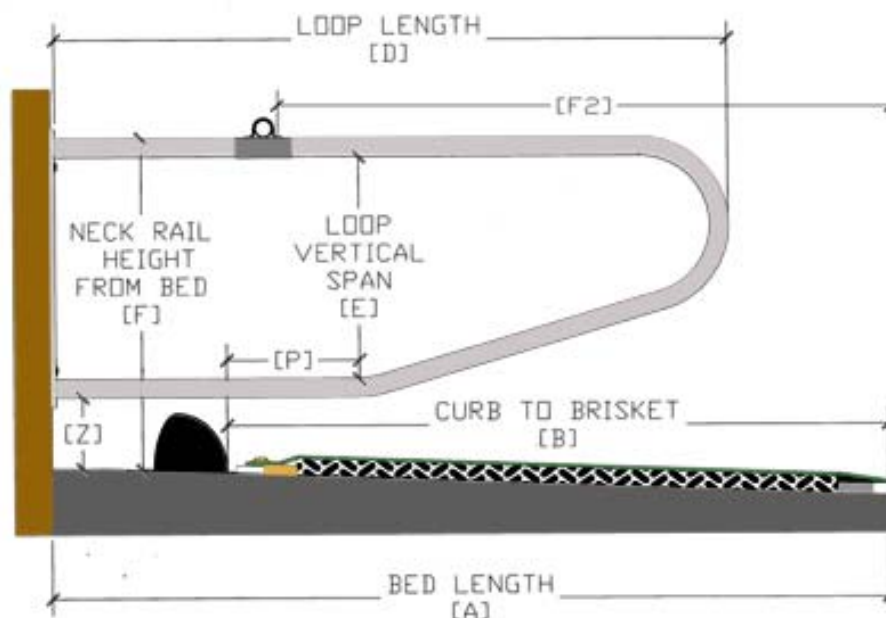

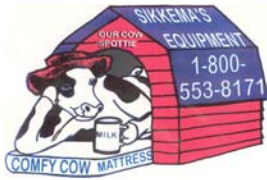
* Z maximum of 10" above bedding-12-14" above rear curb

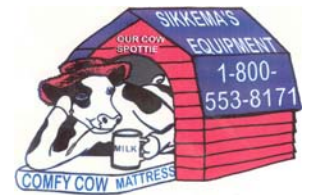
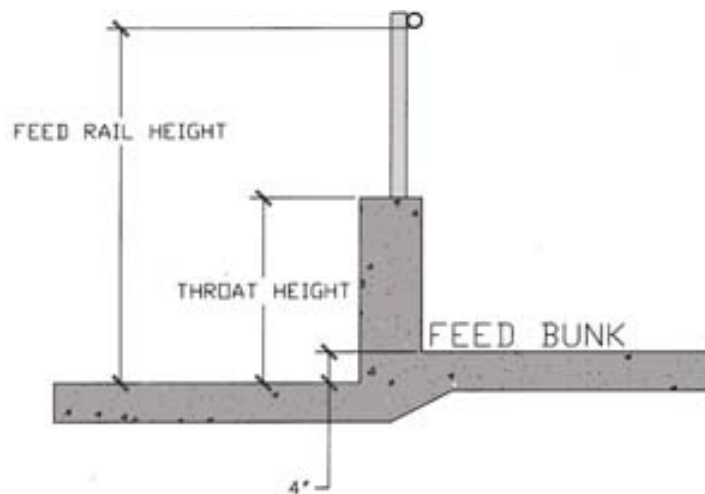




Helpful Feedrail Hints from Sikkema's Equipment
